### Wine, roses event this weekend

"A Night of Wine and Roses" is the annual fund-raising event sponsored by Soroptimist International of Billings. In its 15th year, the auction and wine tasting will start at 7 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 25 at The Depot. The event features a tasting of more than 90 quality wines sponsored by Intermountain Distributing Company. Thomas Nelson Catering will provide hors d'oeuvres. Music for listening and dancing pleasure will be performed by the Swing-A-Roos. A gourmet coffee bar by Todd's Plantation and a premium cash bar will be provided by The Rex.

While this is the 15th annual "Night of Wine and Roses," this year marks a "first" in several respects: this is the first time the event has its venue at The Depot; music for dancing is part of the event; and representatives of wineries, including both owners and wine makers are personally presenting their wines.

The funds raised by the event will be donated to local charities: Baby Think it Over, Family Tree, Yellowstone Rivers & Parks Association and ZooMontana, among other civic causes long supported by the Club.
